WHAT IS THE FIG WORKING WEEK?

FIG was founded in 1878 and is a non-governmental organization of national member associations, cadastral and mapping agencies and ministries, universities and corporates from over 120 countries. FIG covers the whole range of professional fields within the global surveying community, hereunder surveying, cadastre, valuation, mapping, geodesy, geospatial, and quantity surveyors and provides an international forum for discussion and development aiming to promote professional practice and standards

FIG has been organizing Working Weeks since 1878. The first conference was held in Paris from 18-20 July.

FIG Working Week is an exciting week-long conference that brings the international community of surveying and spatial professionals together to share innovative science with policymakers and stakeholders. Scientists, policy- and decision-makers, students, and stakeholders are invited to join the discussions on issues affecting the international surveying and spatial community today and in the future.

Working Weeks combine meetings of FIG's General Assembly and administrative bodies with a technical conference over three days with 10 parallel sessions, organized by FIG Council and the 10 FIG Commissions together with the host member association. Working Weeks offer the opportunity for commissions to implement their work plans and for FIG to network at a local, regional and international level.

Recent Working Weeks have been held in Sofia, Bulgaria (2015), Christchurch, New Zealand (2016), Helsinki Finland (2017), Istanbul, Turkey (2018) and the last one in Hanoi, Viet Nam (2019). The FIG Working Week 2020 will be hosted in Amsterdam, Netherlands at the RAI Convention Centre.






FLOORPLAN (ground floor)






THEME OF THE WORKING WEEK

How to build and manage a densely populated coastal country with a land area of which nearly half is below sea level? We, the Dutch know how to do just that, and have done so for centuries. The role of surveyors in this endeavour has been crucial. And their role is even more crucial today when we must protect our country against the impact of climate change, causing sea level rise.

During the FIG Working Week 2020 in Amsterdam we will address issues and concerns directly affecting FIG's members, focusing on sensing technologies and new spatial data processing technologies based on the ever developing and integrating fields of geodesy and geo-information.

Being in the Netherlands, the FIG Working Week will facilitate the exchange of knowledge, skills and technical expertise in integrated land and water management to address the impacts of climate change, mobility and urban growth.

This brings us to the theme of the FIG Working Week 2020:

Smart Surveyors for Land and Water Management

“Smart surveyors for land and water management can contribute to achieving the global challenges as formulated in the UN Sustainable Development Goals in the coming ten years from now.”

Sub-theme: Smart Surveyors

Rapid urban growth, smart energy, cleaner mobility, and ‘land rights for all’ are some of the challenges demanding innovative surveying approaches and technologies. Sensing technologies, spatial data processing technologies and related approaches are already available. Use and improve them to become future proof, Smart Surveyors!

Sub-theme: Integrated Land and Water management

Without integrated land and water management, the Netherlands cannot sustain its agricultural and urban development. Climate change, though, increases the risks of sea and riverine floods and extended drought periods and complicates this management task. Unorthodox measures are called for. Get familiar with these measures and discuss them from your critical surveyor perspective.

The SDGs are the blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all and surveying professionals have a key role to play. 


