4. Norway Special Issue: Call for Papers

In the spring of 2024, the journal Kart og Plan will have a thematic issue on **cadastral systems and accreditation arrangements** for cadastral surveyors. The background for the issue is that from 1.1.2026, the person who is responsible for carrying out a cadastral survey in Norway must be an authorized land surveyor, fulfilling a legally mandated accreditation requirement. The introduction of an accreditation requirement is a recent development within the field in Norway, presenting new opportunities and challenges for the profession. The editors are looking for articles that address legal, technical and/or ethical issues related to property formation and property registration, practitioners and accreditation requirements. They are not only interested in articles that look at the new Norwegian accreditation system, but also welcome articles that look at accreditation arrangements in other countries, both other Scandinavian countries and further afield.
