2. Report of the activities of commission 9

- Kauko Viitanen participated in the WAVO meeting in Singapore in November
- Kauko Viitanen participated in ACCO-meeting in Bratislava in February
 Some changes to commission 9 work plan 2007-2010

3. Status of Working Groups

WG 9.1 – Compulsory Purchase and Compensations in Land Acquisition and Takings

- Chair Kauko Viitanen presented the status of the seminar
- Seminar will be held on 6.-8. September in Helsinki, Finland
- The seminar has received more than 50 abstracts of papers, about 50 per cent of them will be peer-reviewed paper
- Even though the amount of papers is high there is still a need to get more papers from Europe, Spanish-speaking countries and Islamic countries
- FAO will participate in the seminar and present it's handbook for compulsory purchases

• Presentations at the seminar will be 15 to 30 minutes each

WG 9.2– Improving Slum Conditions through Innovative Financing

- Ann Jennervik presented the status of the working group
- WG has been having plenty of meetings with FIG and UN Habitat to agree on the terms of co-operation
- The project has a webpage at <u>www.justnsustshelter.org</u>, where key issues of the working group are presented. The webpage is designed as an interactive forum and everybody's contribution will be appreciated
- WG two meetings during the Working Week in Hong Kong (Tuesday 16-17 and Wednesday 11-12) as well as one presentation (Monday 16-17)

WG 9.3– Diagnostic Tools and Prescriptive Practices for the Valuation Profession

- Steven Nystrom presented the status of the Working Group
- Aim of the WG is to create a tool to evaluate the valuation system of a country. Most probably, the diagnostic tool will not only have quantitative measures but include only qualitative analysis. Also cultural aspects have to be taken into consideration.

• The tool will be tested on some countries, which will be selected on the basis of data availability. One to two countries from each development level will be studied.

WG 9.4 - Review of Valuation Methods and Standards Worldwide

- Kauko Viitanen presented WG chair David Smejkal's report on the working group
- Aim of the WG is to review and compare valuation methods, standards and reports in different countries.
- David Smejkal has received example reports from the U.S. but would be happy to receive more of them from different countries

WG 9.5 - GIS-analyses in Real Estate Market Analyses and Valuation

- Henning Elmström presented the current situation of the WG.
- The WG is still on planning phase, and interested participants were welcomed.

It was agreed that all Working Group chairs write a short report on the WG to the next Commission 9 newsletter. The newsletter is going to be sent late May or beginning of June.
