



Introduction



- ➤ Land subdivisions
 - > Important for maintenance of cadastre and land book
 - > Important for land use development







Execution of a land subdivision in Norway



- > Cadastral surveying is a municipal responsibility
 - > no licensing of cadastral surveyors in Norway
- Executive officer for land subdivision permits and cadastral surveyor are usually different persons
- > Disputes are resolved in court
 - > Land consolidation court or district court



Executions of land subdivisions in Sweden and Denmark



- > Sweden
- National land survey
 - > The land surveyor executes the land subdivision process
 - > From application to registration
 - Makes decisions about boundaries and rights
 - > Will decide if there is a dispute about boundaries and rights
- Denmark
- Private surveyors
 - > The land surveyor executes the land subdivision process
 - > From application to registration
 - > Handles rights
 - Will decide if there is a boundary dispute



Disputes



- > Denmark: 5 boundary disputes per year brought to court
 - > Totally 50 boundary disputes handled by the land surveyors
- > Sweden: 10 disputes about boundaries and rights brought to court per year
- ➤ Norway:
 - 2008: 600 boundary disputes handled in Land consolidation court







How can the Norwegian system be improved?



- ➤ Licensing of surveyors
- > Field survey prior to permission for land subdivision
- > Coordination of authorities
