

#### Apeldoorn Declaration on Land Consolidation and Land Readjustment for Sustainable Development

We participants of the international symposium on Land Consolidation and Land Readjustment, organized in Apadocom, The Netherlands, U to 11 November 2015; teretry issue the Apadocom Declaration or Land Consolidation and Land Readjustment Nor Substantial Development.

Land consolitietion involves according to FAO:  $\gamma_{(-)}$  (measures to adjust the situature of property rights introducto-ordination between owners and users. Land consolitation involves the satisfication of perceive to action at the decks of fragmentiation but the same gas well beyond these actions. Lend consolitation has been a social with broad economic and accus reterms from the time of the seriest applications'. This definition does not accuse any objectives of land consolidation nor does it promote specific approaches.

Land readjustment involves according to UN HabitatiQLTN: "the pooling of all the land parcels in a particular area and planning them are a unit - pidting in made, severage and other infrastructure -, and then dividing up the land again to the original land owner or user". A proportion of the land is used for made and public space. Each landowner and bed user gets a pict back which is usually smaller than the same he or she anginally contributed to the common pool. Land consolidation and land readjustment are both unbreaks concepts about the authorize of land rights that can be adapted according to context. Comprehensive, first-purpose, periodpatry, and inclusive approaches in land consolidation and land readjustment are provided and should be followed.
