

Legal Aspects on Enriching Authoritative Geospatial Information Using Participatory Mapping Data

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SUMMARY

This paper investigating the legal standing for Participatory Mapping related-aspect towards enriching authoritative geospatial information under the implementation of Geospatial Information Act of Indonesia. The research shows that there is a gap between government vision on providing a legal base to enable participatory mapping and the implementation perceived by participatory mapping actors. Several additional works needed to be done to establish a strong base for effective collaboration regarding authoritative spatial data enrichment. The research is vital as a remark for ongoing collaboration in Indonesia and provides a reference for a similar condition that may exist.
