- Our main goal is to promote the system of the **independent surveyor** working as a public officer or appointed by the public authority.






The Code of Professional Qualifications for Property Surveyors

IG-PARLS – „Constitution“



This CODE defines and recommends necessary professional qualifications and prerequisites as well as professional business and disciplinary requirements.

We are convinced that the Code of professional qualifications is our contribution to ensuring a **high common European professional level** and a **high level of customer protection in legal issues** related to land and property and in other work executed by Property Surveyors.

CONCLUSIONS



- CLGE emphasizes the importance of the protection of property.
