Bio: Prof. Dr.-Ing. Robert Kaden completed his training as a surveying technician in 1999. In 2005 he completed his studies as a qualified engineer in surveying and in 2009 as a Master of Sciences in Geodesy and Geoinformation Sciences at the Technical University of Berlin. In 2014 he received his doctorate in engineering from the Technical University of Munich. He then worked as a project manager in a surveying office and as a postdoc at the Dresden University of Applied Sciences. Since 2018 he has headed the surveying and geoinformatics department at the Erfurt University of Applied Sciences.

Prof. Kaden is a member of the buildingSMART roundtable "BIM and GIS Integration", a member of working group 3: Building Information Modeling of the DVW - Society for Geodesy, Geoinformation and Land Management e. V. He is co-editor of the annually published and renowned guide "Geodesy and BIM" in Germany. For his work, he received the geoinformatics sponsorship award from the Runder Tisch GIS e.V. in 2017, the Oracle Spatial Excellence Award for Education and Research (team award) in 2012, and the Harbert Book Prize from the DVW - Society for Geodesy, Geoinformation and Land Management in 2010. V. and in 2008 the CATCON Gold Award from the International Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing (ISPRS).
