
2. Promoting and Enhancing the Role of FIG

- Capacity building and institutional development
 - Task Force on institutional and professional development
- Global development
 - Cooperation with the UN agencies, World Bank, and international NGO's such as our sister organisations.
 Focus on the global agenda around poverty reduction and sustainable development.
- · Linking the global agenda and the individual surveyors
 - Explaining the relevance and importance of global activities to surveyors at national and local level.
 - Pursued through the Presidents' meeting.

3. Continuing and Enhancing the Dialogue with the Member Associations

- Promoting the benefits of being a member
 - international recognition; global standing of the surveying profession; opportunities to take part in the development of all professional areas.
- Increasing the member base
 - Focus on key regions
- Development of the information and communication policy
 - Vital to a global organisation. Includes the website, annual reports, President's letters, FIG publications, new FIG brochure, on-line journal.
- Establishing a forum for mapping agency chief executives
 - Special sessions at the FIG WW
- Establishing a forum for corporate members
 - FIG ambassador for corporate members
- Including students and young surveyors
 - Easy access to FIG conferences and special sessions for this group







Council Work Plan 2007-2010 (3)

- Promoting FIG as a Global Organisation
 Encouraging global representation in council and commission government
 - This should reflect both regional and cultural diversity, and at the same time ensure democratic elections finding the persons most suitable for the positions
 - Ensuring global distribution of and representation at the FIG conferences
 - Reflecting a truly global perspective of the organisation; facilitating increased participation from developing countries
 - Interacting with regional organisations and respecting cultural diversity
 - Sharing the same values; Increasing the overall standing of the surveying profession.

Responding to the Millennium Goals • Develop a FIG policy on the MDGs with UN and the WB.

- - Establish a UN Liaison Committee to analyse, explain, and present an FIG response to the MDGs
- High level FIG/WB conference in 2008 to promote the FIG global profile in this area
 - Establish a MoU with the World Bank to outline common interests and prepare a high level joint conference in Nov. 2008.

Revising the Conference Structure

- Even years: major conference such as congress and major WW Odd years: WW and regional conferences in partnership with the UN organisations
- Council initiated expert symposia on topical issues e.g. linked to national

Empowering ACCO and the Commissions

- ACCO as a dynamic forum for policy making and professional development
- Enhancing the profile of the technical programme at the conferences
- possibility of peer review
 Establishing a FIG virtual journal
 Establishing task forces to deal with external relations, Intercommission activities, and policy implementation
 Task force on FIG commitment to the UN-Habitat GLTN agenda, including commission 3,7,8 and 9.

8. Sustaining the FIG Office and Finances

- Administration, finance, meeting, events.

 The services provided by the Office must reflect the resources available.
 - Establishing financial reserves of at least 1,5 times the annual expenditure
