Young Professionals of surveying and all related studies within 10 years of graduation from a Bachelor or Masters degree.

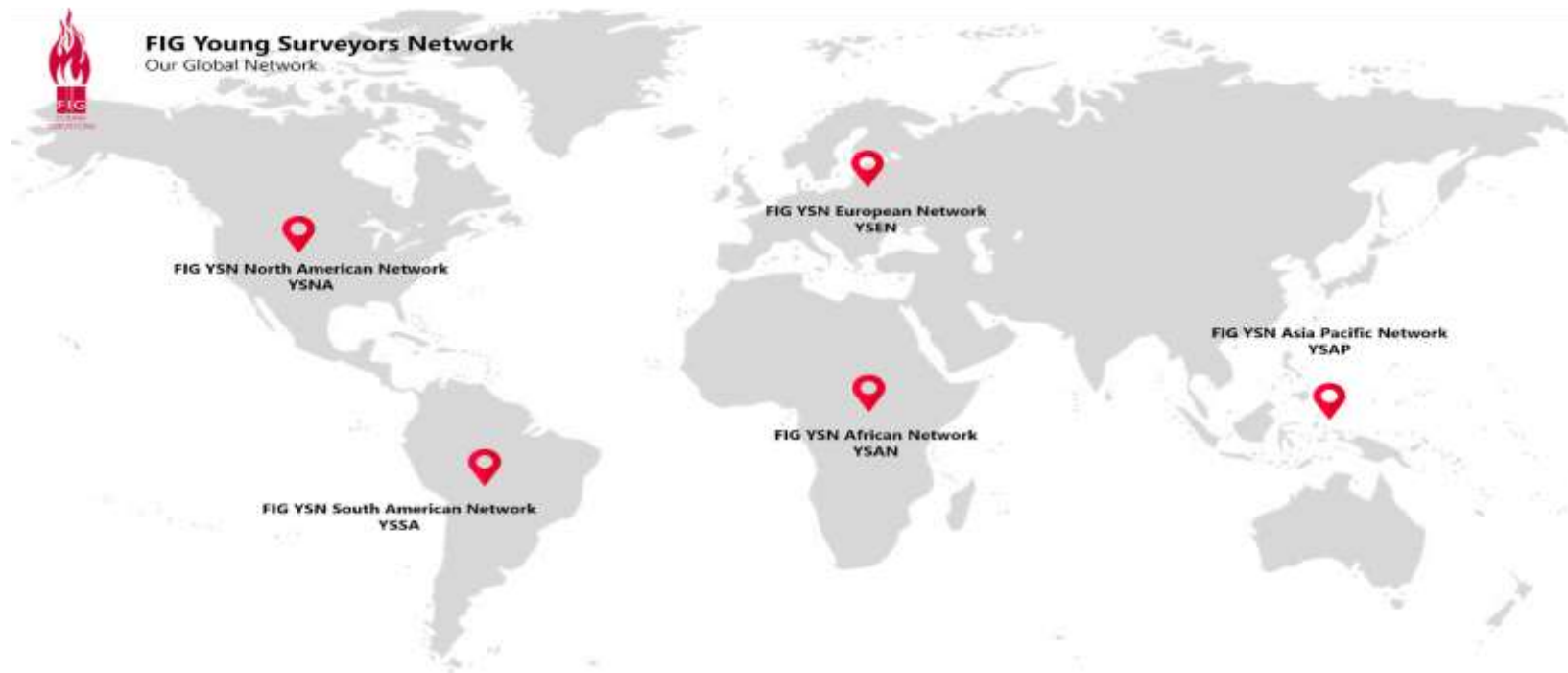

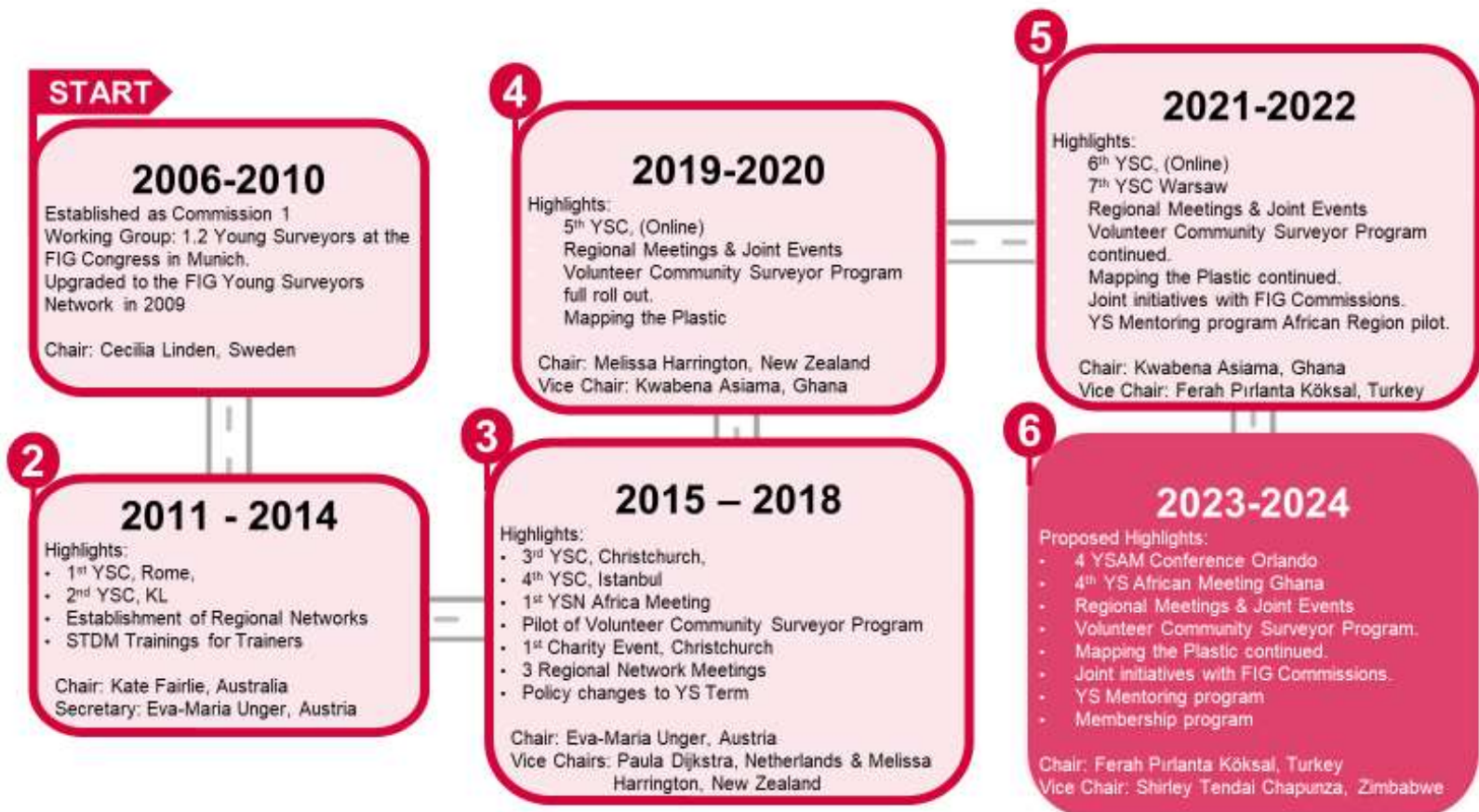

- FIG Mentoring Program

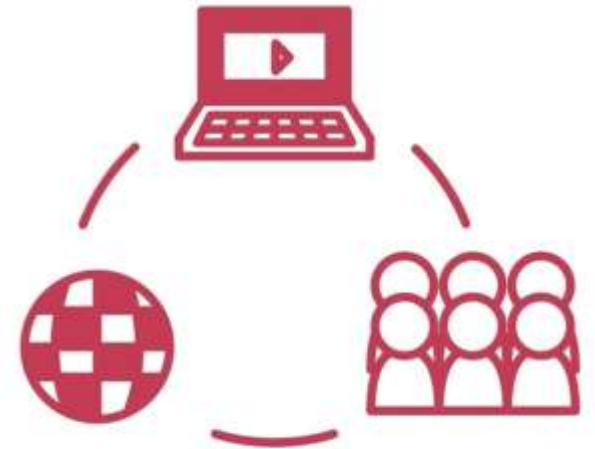
