- Good examples from different countries
- Global programs seem to have impact(Global Surveyors Day, Get kids into Survey, Careers days, Class of Your Own etc)
- Entry level to education is an attention point and recognised across the globe
 - Reduction of fear
 - Review application procedures
 - Show the career paths Clear and Consistent Professional Classifications
 - Short courses
- Social Media is important to get the word out, on the platform the youth is using. This requires time, effort and expertise (of others)

- Member Associations recognise that FIG is an organisation of volunteers, it has strengths and weaknesses.
 - Are we inclusive enough?
- Communication / cooperation: the connections between Member Associations, FIG, commissions can be done better. Information delay / lack of feedback and responses.
 - Clarity of what commissions are working on / delivering Greater visibility
- Definition of surveyors: is it valid and applicable still today?
- Ethics popped up as topic in different groups.
- Recommendation to think about how to respond as FIG to global dynamics (Task Forces could be used as example)
- There is a balance what we can do for FIG, what can FIG do for us?

- Greater interaction with Member Associations
- Member Associations have a responsibility to share FIG information and News among their members
- It would be helpful to communicate the benefits of FIG membership a standard song sheet would assist so the message is consistent around the world.
- Greater interaction between Member Associations, FIG can be the broker/catalyst to do this
- Consider communications channels beyond email, E.g. WhatsApp groups, MS Teams, SLACK etc
- Make a TV Show or Netflix series on "A day in the life of a Surveyor"
- Work more closely with Sponsors to undertake capacity building
- Global Certification Standards led by FIG?
- Consider formation of 4-6 regional networks of FIG for more regular meetings and forums

- Open & Transparent
- Participants can check what is recorded
- Participants feel heard and listened to
- Reduces tension
- Accessible for visual learners and readers
- Helps slow and fast thinkers
- Keeps the work visible for referring back to

Recording the Discussion - How

- A dash (-) for each point
- Lowercase
- Readable from the distance
- Start as soon as someone starts speaking
- Don't worry about spelling
- Link points, *only* when participants ask you to, with a number in a circle next to each comment
- Label each sheet (session, page, recorder's initials)
- Label the question at the top of the paper
- End of session, fold and write details of the session on the outside.
