Why the association wants to nominate Nominee	The Finnish Association of Geodetics and Land Surveyors (MIL) has long traditions in acting as a contact space between its members, promoting the development of the land surveying field, and representing Finnish land surveying in international contexts. The Association has been an active member of FIG, organizing one conference	



	and one working week, and sending delegates to FIG and especially Commission 7 events.
	MIL endorses Assistant Professor Kirsikka Riekkinen for the Chair of Commission 7 for the period of 2027-2030. Kirsikka is MIL member and cadastral surveyor by professional training. She is the only professor teaching cadastral surveying and land administration at master level in Finland, and for the development of international and domestic cadastral surveying and land administration, being part of international community, filling gaps between academy and practice, and international knowledge creation and exchange are of great importance.
	Kirsikka received her PhD in real estate economics in 2014, and the topic of her dissertation was Finnish land administration.
