OVERCOMING THE CHALLENGES OF PROMOTING WLRS VIA THE FFPLA CONCEPT



Promoting women's leadership and participation

Encourage women's active involvement in decisionmaking processes related to land governance, and promote their leadership in community-level land administration initiatives.

Monitoring and evaluation

Establish mechanisms to monitor progress, assess impacts, and identify areas for improvement in promoting WLRs through FFPLA approaches

Securing resources and partnerships

Mobilize financial, technical, and human resources through partnerships with government agencies, civil society organizations, and international development partners



Engaging with communities and stakeholders

 Encourage dialogue and consensus-building on the importance of WLRs and the need for gender-inclusive land governance practices.

Building capacity and awareness

Enhance the capacity of land administration institutions and personnel to address gender disparities and adopt gender-responsive approaches

Reforming legal and policy frameworks

•Advocate for gender-sensitive laws, policies, and institutional frameworks that protect and promote WLRs and address discriminatory practices.
