

Characterization of the Colombian Territorial Administration System: Approaches, dimensions and challenges (2016-2023)

SUMMARY

This project characterizes the Colombian Territorial Administration System between 2016 and 2023. To achieve the objective, the approaches of the TAS are analyzed, the dimensions involved in its mission development are identified, the challenges for its implementation are explained, and its relationship with the Cadastre and governance are analyzed. A qualitative method is adopted, where bibliographic analysis is used as a research technique. The TAS is defined from the approaches of Enemark, Rajabifard and Williamson, whose postulates complement the CONPES documents for its strengthening. The TAS has been characterized as “weak”, it is not formally constituted, and there is still a lack of awareness of the role played by some agents in its implementation. Environmental, economic, political and social dimensions are distinguished. And, the challenges are associated with changes in government, adaptation to regulatory transitions, and shortage of professionals for its development.
